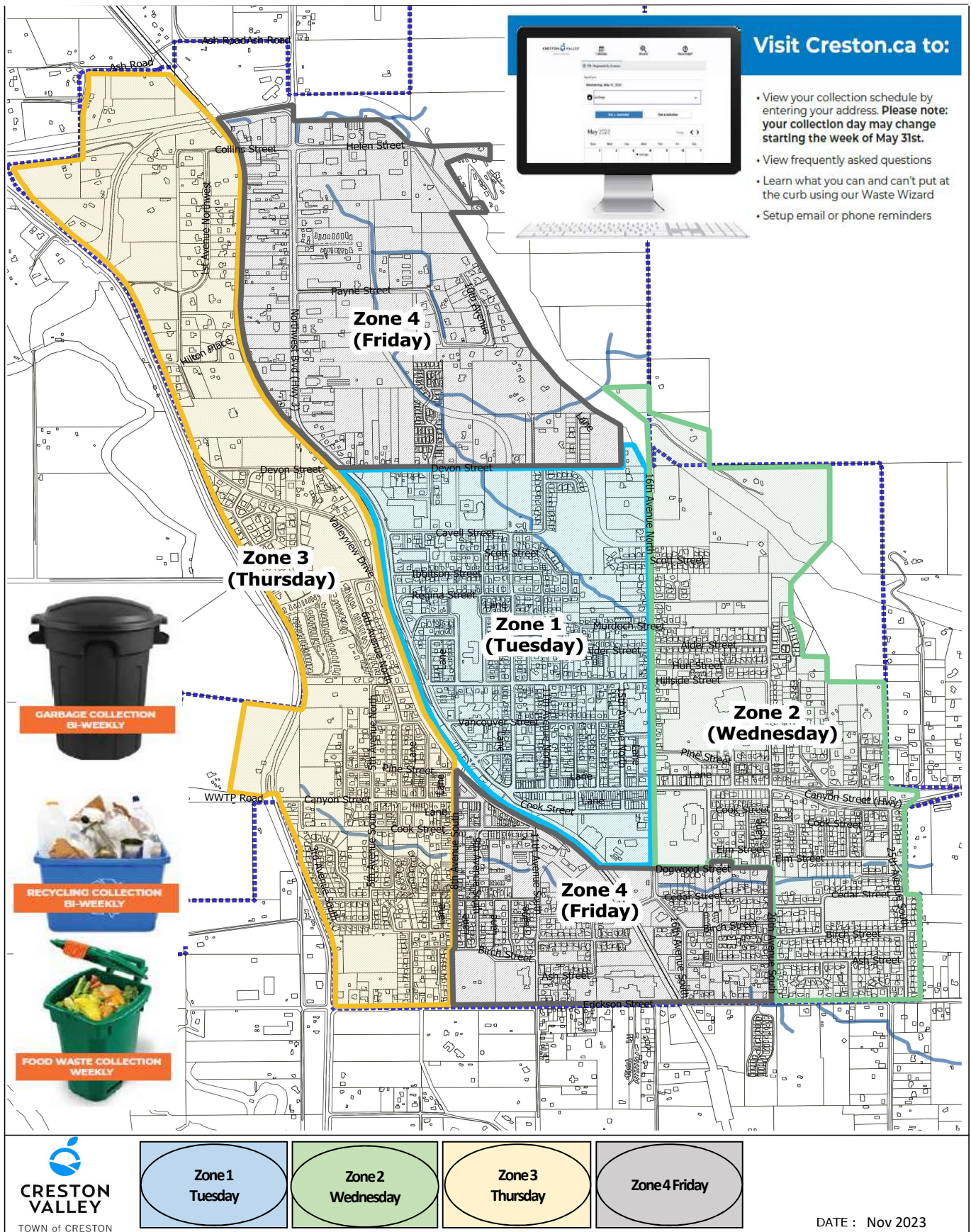
ALL Bins must be out for pickup by 7:00am



Christmas Day p/u will occur on Dec 26

See over for a Map of Collection Zones.

- Each household is permitted a maximum of 23kg (50lbs) of garbage every 2 weeks. Garbage shall be placed in one 120L (max) container or 2 medium sized (65cm x 83cm) plastic bags each weighing up to 11.5kg (25lbs) each. EXTRA garbage requires Tags that are available for purchase at Town Hall.
- All garbage must be bagged, tied securely and placed in your container. Do not place loose items in your garbage container.
- Please ensure your Garbage Container has secure and easy to grip handles.
- Spring and Fall yard waste collection weeks (April, October & November), are subject to change due to weather. Please check at www.creston.ca for updates.
