Instructions:

1. Complete this form and return to the Chief Election Officer at Town Hall, 238 – 10th Avenue North, Creston, BC, or by email at elections@creston.ca, as soon as possible. This form must be received by the Chief Election Officer, or designate, no later than **4:00 pm on Thursday, October 15, 2026**, to receive a mail ballot.
2. Please note that after **October 8, 2026** all mail ballot packages must be picked up at Town Hall.
3. If your application is complete and you qualify to vote, mail ballot packages will be distributed the week of **September 28, 2026**.
4. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer at Town Hall (238 - 10th Avenue North) **no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, October 16, 2026** (preferred), or at the Upper Rotacrest Hall (230 – 19th Avenue North) on **General Voting Day, Saturday, October 17, 2026 no later than 8:00 pm**.
